


Webinar on "Online Predators and Hackers Targeting Youths"







Elimination of Violence Against Women and Cyber Crime

The speeches by the resource persons were highly inspirational and helped raise awareness about rights for women which included: right to life, right for protection, right to education etc.








FEMESSIONALS 2021


Hands-on Training programme for members of Kudumbasree unit

As part of 'National Girl Child Day', Department of Social Work conducted a week long programme with a title 'Girls Revolt' on 18/01/2021






